from around the world, including many papers from China. Elsevier's policy of not requiring papers to be formatted for the journal at first submission is advantageous as it saves time in making the necessary changes. However, time to review is a little longer than for some other journals (although the very short times for some refer to the initial editor decision, not the review process).
